## “The Death and Resurrection of Jesus”

**Jesus Christ** of Nazareth, the Lamb of God, was crucified on Mount Calvary, also known as Golgotha, the place of the skull. Betrayed by the apostle Judas, Jesus was crucified by the Romans, by order of the Ruler Pontius Pilate. The causes of death were crucifixion, extreme exhaustion, severe torture and loss of blood.

Jesus Christ, a descendant of Abraham, was a member of the house of David. He was the Son of the late Joseph, a carpenter of Nazareth, and Mary, his devoted Mother. Jesus was born in a stable in the city of Bethlehem of Judea. He was survived by his mother Mary, his faithful Apostles, numerous disciples, and many other followers.

Jesus was self-educated and spent most of his adult life working as a Teacher. Jesus also occasionally worked as a Medical Doctor and it is reported that he healed many patients. Up until the time of his death, Jesus was teaching and sharing the good news, healing the sick, touching the lonely, feeding the hungry and helping the poor.

Jesus was most noted for telling parables about His Father's Kingdom and performing miracles, such as feeding over 5,000 people with only five loaves of bread and two fish, and healing a man who was born blind. On the day before His death, He held a Last Supper, celebrating the Passover Feast, at which He foretold His death.

After much debate with Caiaphas, the high priest, scribes and elders, He was delivered to Pontius Pilate who washed his hands of the decision and said, “I am innocent of the blood of this just person.”

Jesus was crucified! His body was quickly buried in a stone grave, which was donated by Joseph of Arimathea, a loyal friend of the family. By order of Pontius Pilate, a boulder was rolled in front of the Tomb. Roman Soldiers were put on guard. However, the stone could not hold Him down because on the third day, **He Arose!** His countenance was like lightning, and his raiment white as snow! The angel answered and said to the seeking women, “Fear not ye; for I know that ye seek Jesus, which was crucified. He is not here; for **He Is Risen**, as he said.

Later, Jesus did appear to His disciples. They worshipped him; but some doubted. He spoke to them saying, “**All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.**” He then sent His disciples to baptize and teach all nations.

**“Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost; Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you; and, lo, I am with you alway, even unto the end of the world.”** Amen
